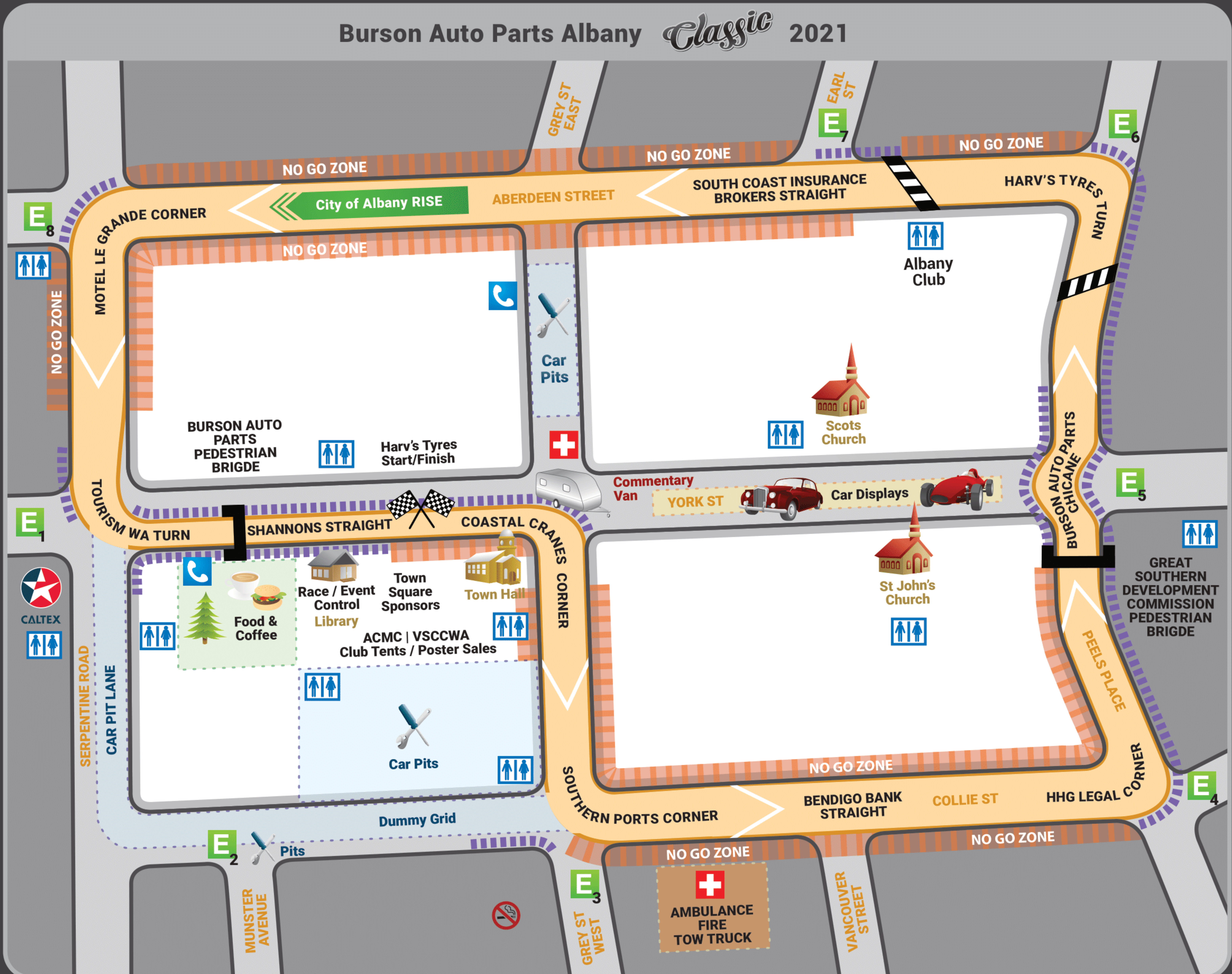

IMPORTANT NOTICE - Motor Racing is Dangerous

SPECTATORS are reminded that motor racing is dangerous and accidents can happen. Spectators enter the circuit area at their own risk. Every care has been taken by the organisers to protect spectators and the general public, however as with every event of this nature, there is the possibility that an accident may happen which causes injury or death of a spectator and/or damage to property. The organisers of this event are required by law to restrict spectator access to viewing areas which are suitably protected by the provision of crash barriers which comply with Motorsports Australia (previously CAMS) and Government regulations. You must stay behind the secondary barriers (wire fence) at all times. DO NOT enter the area between the primary and secondary barriers. Please do not enter or attempt to gain access to any part of the circuit which is not a designated spectator access area or spectator crossing. Children should be closely monitored at all times, if they are within, or in the vicinity of the circuit area. Dogs or any other animals are not permitted within the circuit, even if they are restrained or on a leash. By entering the circuit area, spectators acknowledge that they accept the venue has a degree of danger and that the organising committee, members of the organising committee, clubs, organisations and any other persons having any connection whatsoever with the event shall not have liability to the spectator except in regard to those arising under the Trade Practices Act 1974.
